The UIM Ecoline is a mechanical marking device for hydraulic hoses prior to crimping. It is designed for the precise marking of fitting insertion depth and enables visual verification of hose position inside the ferrule before, during, and after the crimping process.

The device covers hose sizes from DN 5 to DN 32. The marking position is set using a positioning piston. Adjustment time is less than one minute. A spring-loaded counterpart automatically presses the hose against the upper surface of the cylinder. This ensures that hoses of different diameters always align with the same marking groove.

Single or dual markings can be applied. In dual-marking mode, the mark near the hose end must be completely covered by the fitting after assembly. One mark remains visible and serves as direct visual confirmation of correct insertion depth. This principle enables control and countercheck within the assembly process.

A patent application has been filed for the marking system of the UIM Ecoline.

Five-Minute Inventory Checkups Every Branch Should Do

Simple Monthly Habits That Reduce Surprises

Small operational issues often turn into big problems when no one is looking closely. A quick monthly checkup helps branch teams stay ahead of slow-moving buildup, lead-time shifts, and working-capital pressure.

A practical five-minute checklist:

1. Spot the three slowest-moving items this month and ask what changed.
2. Note any rising lead times. This usually signals trouble before pricing does.
3. Review SKUs tied to upcoming transitions (refrigerants, PFAS-sensitive materials, manufacturer updates).
4. Scan for excess safety stock that no longer matches current demand.
5. Pick one item that may need a substitution plan and give customers early notice.

A short monthly routine like this keeps teams aligned, reduces surprises, and supports smarter stocking decisions, without adding complexity.
